### Canada Designates Wheelchair Rugby a Heritage Sport

Earlier this year Wheelchair Rugby was declared a Heritage Sport by the Canadian Federal government, one of only six sports given that designation and the only sport for athletes with a disability to be honoured in this way. The sport was developed in Canada and has risen to Paralympic Status with teams in over 20 countries around the world. Being designated a Heritage Sport recognizes that it all began in Canada.

“I am very proud to have been involved with Wheelchair Rugby since its beginnings and I’m sure the whole Canadian Wheelchair Rugby community is very appreciative of the honour of being designated a Heritage Sport,” says Duncan Campbell, one of the five Canadians who started the game in Winnipeg, MB. Duncan works with the CWSA and is on the 2008 Canada Cup organizing committee.
